Dear Sam:

I am happy to submit this letter of reference and comments about my experience with OccuVax. The Kansas University Endowment Association has been working with OccuVax for the past three years to provide an employer-paid flu vaccine clinic on-site for our employees. We invite our employees to participate via email, they sign up for appointments with OccuVax's handy-dandy on-line registration (we have approximately 100 employees take advantage of this opportunity each year). Prior to the day of the vaccine clinic, all of the supplies are mailed to our location. Then, on the appointed day, OccuVax sends a local nurse on-site to administer the shots.

Quite frankly, I think this is a wonder benefit that we offer our employees. The added advantage is that we have a healthier work force, less absenteeism, and hopefully, employees who appreciate one more benefit provided by our company.

In the past, we worked with our local Health Department to administer the flu vaccines, however, OccuVax makes it so much easier from an administration standpoint, plus the cost per employee is comparable. Additionally, we are able to schedule the OccuVax clinic early in the flu season whereas sometimes working with the Health Department caused delays in getting the clinic schedule or the available vaccine supply.

We plan to continue working with OccuVax in the future and I am happy to report that our experience with Sam and his company have been excellent.
